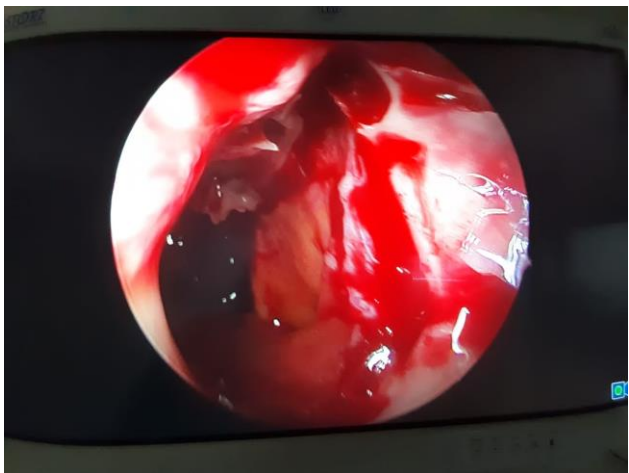
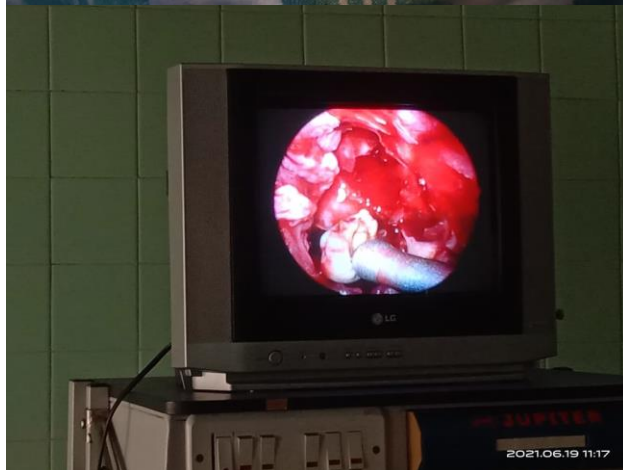
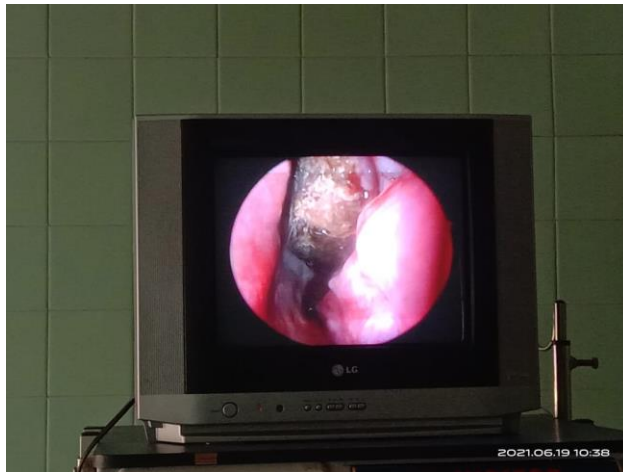


In the Covid 19 pandemic, Govt Erode medical college was one of the institution in Tamilnadu facing challenges of treating patient from the beginning of pandemic and treated more than 5000 patients successfully.

Added to above disease burden, many patients treated for Covid were admitted with mucormycosis a fast spreading dreaded complicating vascular invasive fungal disease. Which needed early diagnosis and aggressive surgical debridement and adequate dose of Amphotericin B and good control of blood sugar is of prime importance in treatment.





GEMCH had admitted and treated about 81 cases of mucormycosis and debridement was done for 26 cases. With the support of our Dean, nodal officer CMCHIS GEMCH and American Tamil Medical Association (ATMA) Co-ordinated by Dr.Ashok Kumar M.D Governor, Florida chapter and president - Elect ATMA, Microdebrider was equipped for management of mucormycosis. It was dramatic milestone in treating mucormycosis and other ENT disorders which can be done with the Microdebrider. With the debridement procedure and simultaneous anti-fungal therapy mutually guided the recovery of mucormycosis patients earlier than the routine.
